Sealed Bids will be received by South Union Township, **at 151 Township Drive, Uniontown, PA 15401 no later than Monday – November 25, 2024 until 1:00 PM (prevailing time)** for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, equipment, transportation, supervision, and the complete performance of all work specified in the Contract for:

SHEEPSKIN TRAIL LIGHTING PROJECT

The scope of work generally includes the installation of light poles, concrete light pole bases, conduit, wiring, and electric connection along the Sheepskin Trail in South Union Township, Fayette County.

Bids must be made on standard proposal forms, in the manner designated therein, and required by the specifications, must be enclosed in sealed envelopes, bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside, addressed to South Union Township and must be accompanied by a Non-Collusion Affidavit and a bid bond or certified check for not less than ten percent (10%) of the base amount bid, and be delivered at the place on or before the hour named above.

All work shall be constructed according to drawings and specifications which are on file at the office of the Owner and K2 Engineering, Inc., 234 Pittsburgh Road, Uniontown, Pennsylvania 15401. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud approximately at **1:05 P.M. on November 25, 2024**, at the Township's Meeting Room. Copies of the Drawings, and the Specifications and Contract Documents may be obtained for Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) from the Engineer plus \$35 for each set to be mailed.

Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, including without limitation, nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids. Owner further reserves the right to reject the Bid of any Bidder whom it finds, after reasonable inquiry and evaluation, to be non-responsible.
